### CAMP DIRECTOR

**Christopher Parsons** is the Head Men's Soccer Coach at Thomas College and has over thirteen years of college coaching experience at the NAIA and NCAA Division I & III level.

Prior to UMF Parsons spent three years at the University of Maine Farmington(D-3) and one year at the University of Maine (D-1) and two seasons as an Assistant Coach at Bowdoin College (D-3) where he helped guide the Polar Bears to an overall 21-7-2 record and an NSCAA top 20 national ranking in both years. Prior to Bowdoin College he was the Head Men's Coach at Saint Joseph's College from 2003-2004 where he led the team to the 2004 NCAA Division III Independent Northeast Regional Tournament.

He began his coaching career as Head Men's Coach at Notre Dame College (NH), posting a 48-11-1 record from 1999 to 2001. The team won the Mayflower Conference Championship in 2000 and advanced to the Northeast Region Championship in 2000 and final four in 2001. The team received NSCAA Top 20 National Rankings in both 2000 and 2001. He was named Mayflower Conference Coach of the Year in 2000 and was a Northeast Region Coach of the Year finalist.

Parsons has a BS in Sports Management from Thomas College and holds the United States Soccer Federation National "B" license.
